



Jamaica Youth Business Trust (JYBT) Alumni Mentoring Programme

The Manchester Business School Alumni (Caribbean Chapter) in keeping with its objective to build local social and entrepreneurial capacity, has partnered with the JYBT to lead its Mentoring activities. The JYBT provides financing, mentoring and advisory support services to approved business ventures of young adults whose social and economic standing make it difficult for them to access capital from traditional modes of financing. Before a loan is disbursed a JYBT approved Mentor will need to be assigned to the loan applicant. **The Business Mentor has a duty to provide advice and guidance before disbursement of the loan or immediately following the disbursement of the loan, and generally be available for a minimum of one hour on a weekly basis in the initial six months of operation and thereafter for on a monthly basis for approximately 3 hours to discuss and review the business – with a 3 year commitment to the programme (preferably) .
